

IBEW 2213 Scholarship Fund Q&A

Q: What are the eligibility requirements?

A: To be eligible for the IBEW 2213 Scholarship, applicants must be a dependent of an active member in good standing and attending an accredited college or university.

Q: Who would be considered a dependent?

A: Anyone in the household claimed on a member's taxes as a dependent.

Q: Can more than one dependent from the same family apply during the same award year?

A: Yes, there is no restriction on the number of applicants from the same household.

Q: Is the scholarship fund limited to undergraduate studies?

A: No, the scholarship can be awarded to graduate students also.

Q: How many times can I apply for the scholarship?

A: There is no limit to the number of times an applicant can apply.

Q: Can the scholarship be awarded to a recipient more than once?

A: No

Q: Will applications received after the deadline be accepted?

A: Applications need to be postmarked by May 31st.

Q: What is acceptable proof of college enrollment?

A: Transcripts or Letter of Acceptance

Q: How will the scholarship money be disbursed?

A: The \$250 award will be paid directly to the recipient's college before the start of the fall semester.

Q: How will I be notified whether or not I have been selected?

A: By letter and email.
