Are you planning to take a Day In Lieu (DIL) for President's Day? According to page **120** of our contract, you have until March 31, 2022 to use your DIL. How does it work? You'll get paid the OT rate for whatever hours you work on the holiday and then you'll take the day of regular pay on the day you use your DIL. You **MUST** work at least **2.75** hours on the holiday to be eligible!

For example, if I work from 8am until noon on President's Day, I'll get paid for 4 hours of OT. That's **\$60.17** per hour (**this is the rep's rate of \$40.11 times 1.5**) for a total of **\$240.68**. Then, when I use the DIL at a later date, I'll get paid **7.5 hours of straight time (\$40.11, a rep's regular rate)** which comes out to **\$300.83**
